NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. The show will be judged according to the NAFAS competitions Manual 2023.
- 2. Exhibits in classes 2, 6, 8 & 9 may be brought pre-done. In all other work, pre-done work must not predominate.
- 3. An exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space specified by the schedule.
- 4. All competitive classes will be staged on the ground floor. The room is light and bright and has a light coloured wooden floor. Own bases may be used.
- 5. All measurements are approximate
- 6. Height of the tabling is 72cms from the floor
- 7. Floral foam should be brought ready soaked.
- 8. No floral foam is allowed in classes 2, 5, 9 and 11 &13.
- 9. No aerosol spray paint may be used in the building.
- The car park adjacent to the building is pay and display. Tea and coffee will be available free of charge during staging.
- 11. Class 7, **imposed**. There is a fee of £25. All components will be supplied by the show committee and may be kept afterwards. Exhibitors do not have to use all the components. Only scissors and cutting tools are permitted. Staging will be 1pm till 2.30pm.
- 12. The petite and miniature classes will be staged by the committee.
- 13. Artificial plant material may be used in classes 2, 6, 8 and 9.
- 14. Watering exhibits will be done by the committee.

Class 1 'Joy to the World'.

A Pedestal Exhibit. Space allowed 120ms x 120cms x height optional. Exhibitor to provide own pedestal and base. To be staged on the floor, with a cream wall background, viewed and judged from the front.

Class 2 'Welcome Home'

A foam free Hanging Exhibit for a front door. Width 50cms x Height 65cms x Depth 25cms. To be hung on a rail at eye level at the front of the stage by a hook (will be provided). Black fabric backing. To be viewed and judged from the front. May be pre-done. Artificial plant material allowed.

Class 3 'Winter Wonderland'

Club Class. To be staged on the floor. Space allowed width 120cms x Depth 120cms Height optional. To be done by a maximum of two members. To be viewed and judged all round. Competitors to provide their own base.

Class 4 'Baby its Cold Outside'

An Exhibit incorporating fabric. Width 90cms x Depth 75cms x Height Optional. To be staged on tabling covered in black fabric with a cream wall background. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 5. Marley's Ghost

A Foam free exhibit. Width 90cms x Depth 75cms x Height Optional. To be staged on tabling covered in black fabric with a cream wall background. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 6. 'Christingle'

A Petite/small Exhibit 25cms x 25cms height optional. Viewed and judged from the front. All exhibits then to be staged by the committee on a round table covered in black cloth. May be pre-done. Artificial plant material allowed

Class 8. 'Starlight'

A miniature Exhibit Width 10cms Depth 10cms height 15cms. To be staged by the committee on a round table covered in black fabric. May be pre-done. Artificial plant material allowed.

Class 9 'A Time for Giving'

Craft Class. Foam free, a decorated parcel. Width 40cms x Depth 40cms Height optional. To be staged on tabling covered in black fabric with a cream wall backing. To be viewed and judged from the front. **May be pre-done. Artificial plant material allowed.**

Class 10. 'The Holly and the Ivy'

Novice exhibit. Width 75cms x Depth 75cms x Height optional. Staged on tabling covered in black fabric with a cream wall backing. Open to everyone who has never won first prize at an Area Show. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 11. 'Main Spring'

A Steam Punk Exhibit. Foam free. Width 90cms, Depth 75cms Height optional. To be staged on open tabling, covered in black fabric. A wooden base 61cms x 61cms painted pewter and raised 4cms from the tabling, will be provided. Viewed from both sides, but judged from the front.

Class 12. 'Twelve Days of Christmas'

A Still Life Exhibit. Width 90cms x Depth 75cms x Height optional. To be staged on open tabling covered in black fabric, viewed from both sides but judged from the front.

Class 13. 'Blow ye Winds Blow'

A foam free Exhibit. Width 100cms Depth 100cms Height optional. To be staged on the floor. Competitors to provide own base. To be viewed and judged all around.
