Classes

Class 1. 'Fairy Dell'

A Petite (Small scale design) Exhibit to be staged on a section of a round table covered in a black cloth. 25cms Width x 25cms Depth x 37cms Height. To be viewed and judged from the front but on open staging.

Class 2. 'The Joy of Flowers'

A Novice Exhibit, 90cms Width x 76cms Depth, Height optional. On tabling covered in black fabric against a white wall. Open to anyone who has not won a first prize at a NAFAS or RHS show.

Class 3. 'Linger Amid the Flowers'

A Pedestal Exhibit, space allowed 120cms Width x 120cms Depth, Height optional. Staged on beige/ cream floor tiles against a grey fabric screen approx. 2 m in height. Competitor to provide own pedestal. To be judged from the front.

Class 4. 'Magic of the Garden'

A Tapestry Exhibit 75cms Width x 75cms Depth, 30cms Height. To be viewed and judged all around, on open tabling covered in black fabric.

Class 5. 'A Decorated Mask for a Garden Party'

A Craft Exhibit 40cms Width x 40cms Depth x 40cms Height. On open tabling covered in black fabric. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Class 6. 'An Evening Walk'

A Meadow Exhibit 90cms Width x 76cms Depth, Height unlimited. On tabling covered with black fabric. Background grey fabric blind. To be view and judged from the front

Class 7. 'From the Woodshed'

A Still Life Exhibit 90cms Width x 76cms Depth, Height Optional. On open tabling covered in black fabric, to be viewed all round but judged from the front.

Class 8. Nature's Sculpture

100cms Width x 100cms Depth Height Optional to be staged on stone flags outside on the terrace. To be viewed and judged from the front.

NB to comply with RHS rules NO OASIS IS ALLOWED IN ANY EXHIBIT AND NO VARIETIES OF BUXUS OR FUCHSIAS ARE ALLOWED ON SITE

NOTES

- To be judged according to NAFAS competition rules.
- Competitive classes are open to all.
- Pre-done work is acceptable in all classes.
- To be staged in the Garden Room at RHS Rosemoor, access for exhibitors through the rear door from the staff carpark. You may be required to move your car to the carpark after offloading.
- Entry is free to the Garden room but should you want to look around the garden, you may be asked to pay.
- Staging times, 10am 3.30pm on Thursday 15 August 2024.
- The judge's decision is final.
- All entries will be accepted in strict rotation until classes are full.
- Natural plant material must predominate in all exhibits.
- Bearing in mind the overall title, preference should be given to plant material that can be grown in UK gardens.
- Artificial plant material is NOT ALLOWED.
- No spray paints to be used in the building.
- Small prizes will be given by the RHS, prize giving will be at 3.30pm on Sunday 18 August.
- Take down will be from 4pm on Sunday 18 August
- Exhibitors own bases and backgrounds may always be used.
- Neither the RHS nor NAFAS takes responsibility for personal injury or loss.
- Please inform the show secretary immediately if you are unable to stage your exhibit.
- A full RHS banned plants' list is available on email. Please apply if you wish to receive one to gillcasey@uwclub.net
- The NAFAS Competitions Manual, if required, can be obtained from www.nafas.org.uk for the price of £5.
- Entering the competition is giving permission for photographs of your exhibit taken by official RHS and NAFAS photographers, possibly being used in future publications.
